- 1 (a) (1) This section does not apply to Baltimore City.
- 2 (2) Subsections (b), (c), (d), and (f) of this section do not apply in Prince 3 George's County.
- 4 (b) (1) The term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1. A county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 6 (2) **\( \begin{aligned} \) Ebruary 1 of the year in which a term ends, the county \) superintendent shall notify the county board whether the superintendent is a candidate for 8 reappointment.**
- 9 (3) (I) [In] SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,
  10 IN the year in which [a] AN INITIAL term begins, the county board shall appoint a county
  11 superintendent between February 1 and June 30. [However, if the county board decides to
  12 reappoint the incumbent superintendent, the county board shall take final action at a
  13 public meeting no later than March 1 of that year.]
- (II) AT ANY POINT DURING THE INCUMBENT

  SUPERINTENDENT'S TERM, THE THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTION AT A PUBLIC

  MEETING TO REAPPOINT THE INCUMBENT SUPERINTENDENT AT ANY TIME AFTER

  THE END OF THE SECOND YEAR OF THE INCUMBENT SUPERINTENDENT'S TERM BUT

  NOT LATER THAN MARCH 1 OF THE YEAR IN WHICH THE CONTRACT IS BEING

  RENEWED TO REAPPOINT THE INCUMBENT SUPERINTENDENT TO SERVE A NEW

  TERM OF 4 YEARS BEGINNING THE IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING JULY 1.
- 21 **(4) (4)** If a county board is unable to appoint a county superintendent by July 1 of a year in which a term begins, the provisions of subsection (d) of this section apply.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025.
