AN ACT

To ensure that the Federal Emergency Management Agency's current efforts to modernize its grant management system includes applicant accessibility and transparency, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "FEMA Accountability,
- 5 Modernization and Transparency Act of 2017".

SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS.

- 2 (a) In General.—The Administrator of the Federal
- 3 Emergency Management Agency shall ensure the ongoing
- 4 modernization of the grant systems for the administration
- 5 of assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
- 6 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.)
- 7 includes the following:
- 8 (1) An online interface, including online assist-
- 9 ance, for applicants to complete application forms,
- submit materials, and access the status of applica-
- tions.
- 12 (2) Mechanisms to eliminate duplication of ben-
- efits.
- 14 (3) If appropriate, enable the sharing of infor-
- mation among agencies and with State, local, and
- tribal governments, to eliminate the need to file mul-
- tiple applications and speed disaster recovery.
- 18 (4) Any additional tools the Administrator de-
- termines will improve the implementation of this sec-
- tion.
- 21 (b) Implementation.—To the extent practicable,
- 22 the Administrator shall deliver the system capabilities de-
- 23 scribed in subsection (a) in increments or iterations as
- 24 working components for applicant use.

1 SEC. 3. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.

- 2 No additional funds are authorized to carry out the
- 3 requirements of this Act. Such requirements shall be car-
- 4 ried out using amounts otherwise authorized.
