A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to administer vaccinations for hepatitis A, at no cost to the inoculated, in certain areas at risk of a hepatitis A outbreak.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hepatitis Exposure
- 5 Prevention Act of 2019" or the "HEP A Act of 2019".

1 SEC. 2. VACCINATION FOR HEPATITIS A IN AREAS AT RISK

- 2 OF A HEPATITIS A OUTBREAK.
- 3 The Secretary of Health and Human Services, acting
- 4 directly or by entering into contracts or awarding grants,
- 5 may administer vaccinations for hepatitis A, at no cost
- 6 to the inoculated, in any area within a State for which
- 7 there is in effect a declaration by the Governor of the
- 8 State designating such area as at risk of a hepatitis A
- 9 outbreak.
