A SENATE RESOLUTION ELECTING KATHRYN CRISP GREELEY TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

Whereas, Lee Roberts of Wake County was elected by the Senate in 2021 to serve as a member of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for a term of four years; and

Whereas, Lee Roberts resigned from the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina in January 2024; and

Whereas, G.S. 116-7(c) directs the chamber that originally elected a vacating member of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina to elect a person to fill that vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

Whereas, the Senate may determine its own procedure, and the Chair of the Senate Select Committee on Nominations has confirmed that Kathryn Crisp Greeley has no disqualifying statutory disabilities; Now, therefore,
