#### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Eliminate Network

- 5 SEC. 2. PRESERVATION OF REPORTS TO CYBERTIPLINE RE-
- 6 LATED TO ONLINE SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF
- 7 CHILDREN.
- 8 Section 2258A(h) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 9 amended—
- 10 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "90 days" and
- inserting "180 days"; and
- 12 (2) by adding at the end the following:
- 13 "(5) Extension of Preservation.—A pro-
- vider of a report to the CyberTipline under sub-
- section (a)(1) may voluntarily preserve the contents
- provided in the report (including any comingled con-
- tent described in paragraph (2)) for longer than 180
- days after the submission to the CyberTipline for
- the purpose of reducing the proliferation of online
- 20 child sexual exploitation or preventing the online
- 21 sexual exploitation of children.
- 22 "(6) Method of Preservation.—Not later
- than 1 year after the date of enactment of this para-
- graph, a provider of a report to the CyberTipline
- under subsection (a)(1) shall preserve materials
- under this subsection in a manner that is consistent

- 1 with most recent version of the Cybersecurity
- 2 Framework developed by the National Institute of
- 3 Standards and Technology, or a successor re-
- 4 source.".
