Mr. Scott of Florida (for himself and Mr. Marshall) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

- To prohibit the use of Federal funds to purchase at-home tests for SARS-CoV-2 that are imported from, or manufactured in, the People's Republic of China.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "No Taxpayer Dollars
 - 5 for Communist China COVID Tests Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USING FEDERAL FUNDS TO PUR-
 - 7 CHASE CERTAIN TESTS.
 - 8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
 - 9 eral funds may be used to purchase any at-home test for

- 1 SARS–CoV–2 that is imported from the People's Republic
- 2 of China, or that was manufactured, in whole or in part,

3 in the People's Republic of China.
