## **A BILL**

To prohibit the reduction, elimination, or suspension of funding for land-grant colleges and universities.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON REDUCTION, ELIMINATION,
4 OR SUSPENSION OF FUNDING FOR LAND5 GRANT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.
6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture, or
7 any other Federal official, may not take any action to re-

- 1 duce, eliminate, or suspend funding for land-grant colleges
- 2 and universities, unless such reduction, elimination, or
- 3 suspension is specifically authorized by an Act of Con-
- 4 gress.
- 5 (b) Land-Grant Colleges and Universities De-
- 6 FINED.—In this section, the term "land-grant colleges and
- 7 universities" has the meaning given such term in section
- 8 1404 of the National Agricultural Research, Extension,
- 9 and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3103).
