Mr. AGUILAR (for himself and Mr. CALVERT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

## A BILL

To provide for joint reports by relevant Federal agencies to Congress regarding incidents of terrorism, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Reporting Efficiently
- 5 to Proper Officials in Response to Terrorism Act of 2017"
- 6 or the "REPORT Act".
- 7 SEC. 2. DUTY TO REPORT.
- 8 (a) Duty Imposed.—Whenever an incident of ter-
- 9 rorism occurs in the United States, it shall be the duty
- 10 of the Secretary of Homeland Security, in coordination

- 1 with the Attorney General, the Director of the Federal Bu-
- 2 reau of Investigation, and, as appropriate, the head of the
- 3 National Counterterrorism Center, to submit, not later
- 4 than upon completion of the investigation by the primary
- 5 Government agency conducting the investigation, an un-
- 6 classified report (which may be accompanied by a classi-
- 7 field annex) to Congress concerning that incident.
- 8 (b) Content of Reports.—A report under this sec-
- 9 tion shall contain—
- 10 (1) a statement of the facts of the incident, as
  11 known at the time of the report; and
- 12 (2) any recommendations for changes in prac-
- tices or law, consistent with the Constitution, with
- particular attention to changes that could help pre-
- vent future attacks.
- 16 (c) Definition.—In this section, the term "incident
- 17 of terrorism" means an event declared by the Federal Bu-
- 18 reau of Investigation to be an act of terrorism.
