## A BILL

To amend the Older Americans Act of 1965 to require reports to Congress on State Long-Term Care Ombudsman Programs, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Long-Term Care
- 5 Transparency Act".

### SEC. 2. REPORTING ON STATE LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDS-2 MAN PROGRAMS. 3 Chapter 2 of subtitle A of title VII of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3058f et seq.) is amended 5 by adding at the end the following: 6 "SEC. 714. REPORTS TO CONGRESS. 7 "Each year, the Assistant Secretary shall submit, to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions and the Special Committee on Aging of the Senate 9 and the Committee on Education and the Workforce of 10 the House of Representatives, a report that— 11 "(1) aggregates all reports submitted under sec-12 tion 712(h) for such year; and 13 "(2) provides a summary of the findings of 14 15 such reports.".
