A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving the Gibson Dam.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT AND EXTENSION OF TIME
- 4 FOR FEDERAL ENERGY REGULATORY COM-
- 5 MISSION PROJECT INVOLVING GIBSON DAM.
- 6 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
- 7 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
- 8 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
- 9 mission project numbered 12478–003, the Federal Energy

- 1 Regulatory Commission (referred to in this section as the
- 2 "Commission") shall, at the request of the licensee for the
- 3 project, after reasonable notice, and in accordance with
- 4 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest require-
- 5 ments of, and the procedures of the Commission under,
- 6 that section, reinstate the license and extend the time pe-
- 7 riod during which the licensee is required to commence
- 8 construction of the project for the 6-year period that be-
- 9 gins on the date of enactment of this Act.
