The Authority shall submit to the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States and

- requirements of section 25F of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. § 25F) and are located in this State. As part of the submission, the Authority shall certify its authority to submit the list on behalf of the State and comply with any other requirements of 26 U.S.C. § 25F, its associated regulations, or other applicable guidance issued by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States.
- (b) The Authority may establish rules governing the process and documentation necessary for an entity to qualify to be included as a scholarship granting organization on the list produced and submitted by the Authority pursuant to subsection (a) of this section and in accordance with 26 U.S.C. § 25F, its associated regulations, or other applicable guidance issued by the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States.
- (c) The Authority may enter into an agreement with other State agencies, including the Department of Revenue, to meet the requirements of this section."
- **SECTION 3.** The State Education Assistance Authority shall comply with all federal regulations pertaining to the administration of the federal tax credit established under 26 U.S.C. § 25F to ensure that the State is eligible to participate in taxable years beginning after December 31, 2026.
- **SECTION 4.** In accordance with 26 U.S.C. § 25F and any applicable federal regulation and guidance, qualifying scholarship granting organizations on the list produced pursuant to G.S. 116-204(14), as enacted by this act, may provide scholarships for any qualified elementary or secondary education expense, including home school expenses, to the extent allowed under federal law.
 - **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
