A BILL

To amend the Older Americans Act of 1965 to provide equal treatment of LGBT older individuals, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Ruthie and Connie
- 5 LGBT Elder Americans Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

"(B) To be eligible to receive funds under this sub-16 17 section, an entity shall submit an application to the Assist-18 ant Secretary at such time, in such manner, and containing such information as the Assistant Secretary may 19 20 require. 21 "(5) The Assistant Secretary shall make available to the Center on an annual basis such resources as are nec-23 essary for the Center to carry out effectively the functions of the Center under this Act and not less than the amount of resources made available to the National Resource Cen-
