A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to expand the use of telehealth for individuals with stroke.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Furthering Access to
- 5 Stroke Telemedicine Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPANDING THE USE OF TELEHEALTH FOR INDI-
- 7 VIDUALS WITH STROKE.
- 8 Section 1834(m) of the Social Security Act (42
- 9 U.S.C. 1395m(m)) is amended by adding at the end the
- 10 following new paragraph:

1	"(5) Treatment of stroke telehealth
2	SERVICES.—
3	"(A) Non-application of originating
4	SITE REQUIREMENTS.—The requirements de-
5	scribed in paragraph (4)(C) shall not apply with
6	respect to telehealth services furnished on or
7	after January 1, 2018, for purposes of evalua-
8	tion of an acute stroke, as determined by the
9	Secretary.
10	"(B) No originating site facility
11	FEE.—The Secretary shall not pay an origi-
12	nating site facility fee (as described in para-
13	graph (2)(B)) with respect to such telehealth
14	services.".
