13 Bellaire and Sara Frances Krudop; he graduated from Andalusia

15 WHEREAS, Dr. Krudop attained a Bachelor of Science
16 Degree from Auburn University and a Master of Arts Degree and
17 a Doctor of Education Degree from The University of Alabama;

19 WHEREAS, Dr. Krudop's work experience in the field
20 of education over a period of more than 44 years includes Dean
21 of Student Affairs, Dean of Students/Administration, Dean of
22 Student Development, Dean of the College, Dean of the
23 College/Second-in-Command, Vice President and Dean of
24 Administrative and Instructional Services, Vice President and
25 MacArthur Campus Director, Vice President of the Greenville
26 Campus, and Vice President and Director of the Greenville
27 Campus; and

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Krudop's commitment to excellence has
2 been recognized by his selection for the Michael Bennett
