A BILL

To direct the Joint Committee of Congress on the Library to obtain a statue of Shirley Chisholm for placement in the United States Capitol.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PLACEMENT OF STATUE OF SHIRLEY CHIS-
- 4 HOLM IN UNITED STATES CAPITOL.
- 5 (a) Obtaining Statue.—Not later than 2 years
- 6 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Joint Com-
- 7 mittee of Congress on the Library shall enter into an

- 1 agreement to obtain a statue of Shirley Chisholm, under
- 2 such terms and conditions as the Joint Committee con-
- 3 siders appropriate consistent with applicable law. The
- 4 Joint Committee may authorize the Architect of the Cap-
- 5 itol to enter into the agreement and related contracts re-
- 6 quired under this subsection on its behalf, under such
- 7 terms and conditions as the Joint Committee may require.
- 8 (b) Placement.—The Joint Committee of Congress
- 9 on the Library shall place the statue obtained under sub-
- 10 section (a) in a permanent public location in the United
- 11 States Capitol.
- 12 (c) Authorization of Appropriations.—There
- 13 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
- 14 necessary to carry out this Act, and any amounts so ap-
- 15 propriated shall remain available until expended.
