A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. RUTLEDGE PEARSON POST OFFICE BUILDING.
- 4 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 5 Postal Service located at 1100 Kings Road in Jacksonville,

- 1 Florida, shall be known and designated as the "Rutledge
- 2 Pearson Post Office Building".
- 3 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 6 be deemed to be a reference to the "Rutledge Pearson
- 7 Post Office Building".
