2 **Labor and Employment – Uninsured Employers’ Fund Board – Membership and**
3 **Reserves**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Uninsured Employers’ Fund Board;
5 requiring, rather than authorizing, the Board to establish reserves to meet potential
6 losses of the Uninsured Employers’ Fund; and generally relating to the Uninsured
7 Employers’ Fund.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Labor and Employment**

16 10–308.

17 (a) (1) The Board consists of [3] **FIVE** members, appointed by the Governor
18 with the advice and consent of the Senate.

19 (2) Of the [3] **FIVE** members of the Board:

(i) [1 shall represent labor] **TWO SHALL HAVE SUBSTANTIAL EXPERIENCE AS OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES OF A PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE COMPANY;**

(ii) [1 shall represent management; and] **ONE SHALL HAVE SUBSTANTIAL EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ACCOUNTING OR FINANCE;**

(iii) [1 shall represent the general public] **ONE SHALL BE A POLICYHOLDER OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE ISSUED IN THE STATE; AND**

(IV) ONE SHALL REPRESENT THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

(b) Before taking office, each appointee to the Board shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.

(c) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.

(2) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(d) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.

The Board [may] **SHALL** establish reserves to meet potential losses of the Fund.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
