To amend the Social Security Act to authorize grants and training to support area agencies on aging and other community-based organizations in addressing social isolation among older individuals and adults with disabilities.

## A BILL

To amend the Social Security Act to authorize grants and training to support area agencies on aging and other community-based organizations in addressing social isolation among older individuals and adults with disabilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Addressing Social Iso-
- 5 lation and Loneliness in Older Adults Act of 2023" or the
- 6 "Addressing SILO Act of 2023".

1	SEC. 2. GRANTS AND TRAINING TO SUPPORT AREA AGEN-
2	CIES ON AGING OR OTHER COMMUNITY-
3	BASED ORGANIZATIONS TO ADDRESS SOCIAL
4	ISOLATION AMONG OLDER INDIVIDUALS AND
5	ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES.
6	Part II of subtitle B of title XX of the Social Security
7	Act (42 U.S.C. 1397m et seq.) is amended by adding at
8	the end the following:
9	"SEC. 2047. GRANTS AND TRAINING TO SUPPORT AREA
10	AGENCIES ON AGING OR OTHER COMMUNITY-
11	BASED ORGANIZATIONS TO ADDRESS SOCIAL
12	ISOLATION AMONG OLDER INDIVIDUALS AND
13	ADULTS WITH DISABILITIES.
14	"(a) Grants.—The Secretary shall make grants to
15	eligible area agencies on aging or other community-based
16	organizations for the purpose of—
17	"(1) conducting outreach to older individuals
18	and adults with disabilities at risk for, or already ex-
19	periencing, social isolation or loneliness, through es-
20	tablished screening tools or other methods identified
21	by the Secretary;
22	"(2) developing community-based interventions
23	for the purposes of mitigating loneliness or social
24	isolation (including evidence-based programs, as de-
25	fined by the Secretary, developed with multi-stake-
26	holder input for the purposes of promoting social

- 1 connection, mitigating social isolation or loneliness,
- 2 or preventing social isolation or loneliness) among
- 3 older individuals and adults with disabilities de-
- 4 scribed in paragraph (1);
- 5 "(3) connecting such older individuals and 6 adults with disabilities with community social and 7 clinical supports; and
- 8 "(4) evaluating the effect of programs devel-9 oped and implemented under paragraphs (2) and 10 (3).
- 11 "(b) Training.—
- "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish programs to provide and improve training for
  area agencies on aging or community-based organizations with respect to addressing and preventing
  social isolation and loneliness among older individuals and adults with disabilities.
  - "(2) PRIORITIZATION AUTHORITY.—For purposes of connecting at-risk individuals with existing community social and clinical supports, the Secretary may, in carrying out paragraph (1), prioritize models that incorporate training and service delivery in coordination with medical-legal partnerships.
- 24 "(c) EVALUATION.—Not later than 3 years after the 25 date of enactment of this section and every 3 years there-

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- 1 after, the Secretary shall submit to Congress a written re-
- 2 port that assesses the extent to which the programs estab-
- 3 lished under this section address social isolation and lone-
- 4 liness among older individuals and adults with disabilities.
- 5 "(d) APPROPRIATION.—Out of any money in the
- 6 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, there is appro-
- 7 priated to the Secretary \$62,500,000 for each of fiscal
- 8 years 2024 through 2028, to remain available until ex-
- 9 pended, to carry out this section.
- 10 "(e) COORDINATION.—The Secretary shall coordinate
- 11 with resource centers, grant programs, or other funding
- 12 mechanisms established under section 411(a)(18) of the
- 13 Older Americans Act (42 U.S.C. 3032(a)(18)), section
- 14 417(a)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 3032f(a)(1)), or other
- 15 programs as determined by the Secretary.
- 16 "(f) Definitions.—In this section:
- 17 "(1) Adult with a disability.—The term
- 18 'adult with a disability' means an individual with a
- disability as defined in section 372 of the Older
- 20 Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3030s).
- 21 "(2) Area agency on aging.—The term 'area
- agency on aging' means an area agency on aging
- designated under section 305 of such Act (42 U.S.C.
- 24 3025).

- "(3) COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION.—The term 'community-based organization' includes, ex-cept as otherwise provided by the Secretary, a non-profit community-based organization, a consortium of nonprofit community-based organizations, a na-tional nonprofit organization acting as an inter-mediary for a community-based organization, or a community-based organization that has a fiscal sponsor that allows the organization to function as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from taxation under section 501(a) of such Code.
  - "(4) LONELINESS.—The term 'loneliness' means subjectively feeling alone, or the discrepancy between one's desired level of social connection and one's actual level of social connection.
  - "(5) OLDER INDIVIDUAL.—The term 'older individual' has the meaning given such term in section 102 of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3002).
  - "(6) Social connection.—The term 'social connection' means the variety of ways one can connect with others socially, through physical, behavioral, social-cognitive, and emotional channels.

1 "(7) SOCIAL ISOLATION.—The term 'social iso-2 lation' means objectively being alone, or having few 3 relationships or infrequent social contact.".

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
