## A BILL

- To require the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to conduct a program to use simplified procedures to issue public assistance for certain projects under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Disaster Simplified
  - 5 Assistance Value Enhancement Act" or the "Disaster
  - 6 SAVE Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. SIMPLIFIED PROCEDURE PROGRAM.

- 2 (a) Threshold.—The Administrator shall imme-
- 3 diately establish the threshold for eligibility pursuant to
- 4 section 422(b)(2) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
- 5 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5189(b)(2)) at
- 6 \$500,000.
- 7 (b) Report.—Not later than May 1, 2021, the Ad-
- 8 ministrator shall submit to the Committee on Homeland
- 9 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the
- 10 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
- 11 House a report on the comprehensive review of the Pro-
- 12 gram conducted under this section, to include an assess-
- 13 ment of cost-effectiveness, speed of recovery, capacity of
- 14 the grantees, past performance and accountability meas-
- 15 ures.
- 16 (c) SUNSET.—This Act shall expire on September 30,
- 17 2021.

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
