A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to conduct a program to use simplified procedures to issue public assistance for certain projects under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disaster Simplified
5 Assistance Value Enhancement Act” or the “Disaster
6 SAVE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SIMPLIFIED PROCEDURE PROGRAM.**

2 (a) THRESHOLD.—The Administrator shall imme-
3 diately establish the threshold for eligibility pursuant to
4 section 422(b)(2) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
5 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5189(b)(2)) at
6 \$500,000.

7 (b) REPORT.—Not later than May 1, 2021, the Ad-
8 ministrator shall submit to the Committee on Homeland
9 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the
10 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
11 House a report on the comprehensive review of the Pro-
12 gram conducted under this section, to include an assess-
13 ment of cost-effectiveness, speed of recovery, capacity of
14 the grantees, past performance and accountability meas-
15 ures.

16 (c) SUNSET.—This Act shall expire on September 30,
17 2021.
