To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to develop best practices for caring for high-risk military occupation veterans as part of the evaluation of mental health care and suicide prevention programs administered by the Secretary.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "High-Risk Military Oc-
- 5 cupation Veteran Suicide Prevention Act".

1	SEC. 2. CARE OF HIGH-RISK MILITARY OCCUPATION VET-
2	ERANS IN DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-
3	FAIRS MENTAL HEALTH CARE AND SUICIDE
4	PREVENTION PROGRAMS.
5	Subparagraph (E) of section 1709B(a)(2) of title 38,
6	United States Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	"(E) propose best practices for caring for
8	individuals who suffer from mental health dis-
9	orders, are at risk of suicide, or previously held
10	high-risk military occupations, including such
11	practices conducted or suggested by other de-
12	partments or agencies of the Federal Govern-
13	ment, including the Substance Abuse and Men-
14	tal Health Services Administration of the De-
15	partment of Health and Human Services; and".
