## 2 Natural Resources – Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Certificates – Digital or Electronic Format

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to make available and, 5 on request, issue certain licenses, permits, registrations, and certificates in a digital 6 or electronic format; establishing that an individual may satisfy certain 7 requirements to possess or display a license, permit, registration, or certificate by 8 possessing or displaying the document in a certain digital or electronic format; 9 requiring the Department to design certain digital or electronic documents in a certain manner; and generally relating to licenses, permits, registrations, and 10 11 certificates issued by the Department of Natural Resources.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 24 Article – Natural Resources

25 1–403.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the Department may 2 develop and implement an electronic system for the sale and issuance of licenses, permits, 3 and registrations and the recording and releasing of security interests.
- 4 (b) The electronic system may include provisions for:
- 5 (1) Recording titling and registration data;
- 6 (2) Recording and releasing liens without the issuance of a security interest 7 filing; and
- 8 (3) Recording information relating to an application for a license, permit, 9 or registration.
- 10 (c) The Department shall develop the electronic system consistent with the 11 statewide information technology master plan developed under Title 3A, Subtitle 3 of the 12 State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 13 (g) The Department may adopt regulations to:
- 14 (1) Implement the electronic system authorized under this section; and
- 15 (2) Determine the appropriate fee levels that may be charged by a vendor 16 and by the Department for the electronic transmission service.

- 18 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE AND, ON REQUEST, ISSUE ANY LICENSE, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS
- 20 ARTICLE IN A DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC FORMAT.
- 21 **(B) (1)** AN INDIVIDUAL MAY SATISFY ANY REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS 22 ARTICLE TO POSSESS OR DISPLAY A LICENSE, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR 23 CERTIFICATE BY POSSESSING OR DISPLAYING THE DOCUMENT IN A DIGITAL OR 24 ELECTRONIC FORMAT AS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 25 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN THE DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC
  26 DOCUMENTS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS THE
  27 DOCUMENT HOLDER TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL POSSESSION OF THE DEVICE ON WHICH
  28 THE DOCUMENT IS ACCESSED DURING VERIFICATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2021.
