- 5 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 6 Postal Service located at 5707 South Cass Avenue in

- 1 Westmont, Illinois, shall be known and designated as the
- 2 "James William Robinson Jr. Memorial Post Office Build-
- 3 ing".
- 4 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 6 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 7 be deemed to be a reference to the "James William Robin-
- 8 son Jr. Memorial Post Office Building".
