- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.
- 4 The building utilized as a United States courthouse
- 5 located at 111 South Highland Avenue in Jackson, Ten-
- 6 nessee, shall be known and designated as the "James D.
- 7 Todd United States Courthouse" during the period in

- 1 which the building is utilized as a United States court-
- 2 house.
- 3 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.
- 4 With respect to the period in which the building re-
- 5 ferred to in section 1 is utilized as a United States court-
- 6 house, any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 7 paper, or other record of the United States to that build-
- 8 ing shall be deemed to be a reference to the "James D.
- 9 Todd United States Courthouse".
