## Baltimore County - Board of Education - Membership and Election of Officers

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members serving on the Baltimore County Board of Education; requiring the Baltimore County Executive to appoint a member 4 5 of the county board from a certain list of nominees within a certain period of time; 6 altering the processes of the Baltimore County School Board Nominating 7 Commission to require the Commission to forward a list of nominees to an appointing 8 official; altering the quorum requirements for election of the chair and vice chair of 9 the county board; and generally relating to the membership and election of officers for the Baltimore County Board of Education. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
