27	(1) As used in this section:

28	(a) "Commission" means the Jordan River Commission created by interlocal
29	agreement.
30	(b) "Zone" means the Jordan River Recreation Area, the area 250 yards on each side of
31	the Jordan River from the edge of the river between SR-201 and 4800 South.
32	(2) The division, subject to applicable federal, state, and local laws and ordinances and
33	Subsections (3) and (4), may:
34	(a) expend money for the following purposes:
35	(i) enhancing safety, recreation, and conservation in the zone;
36	(ii) capital improvements within the zone, including:
37	(A) lighting along the Jordan River and within the zone;
38	(B) completing construction of a paved pathway on both sides of the Jordan River
39	within the zone;
40	(C) building a boat launch, picnic pavilion, bench, restroom, or other amenity within
41	the zone; and
42	(D) supporting Tracy Aviary, a nature area, bike or boat rental concessionaire, or other
43	partnerships to enhance recreation in the zone;
44	(iii) funding programs to:
45	(A) clean the zone[;];
46	(B) remove invasive species[;]; and
47	(C) restore riparian habitat;
48	(iv) hiring or contracting for personnel to perform tasks as directed by the commission;
49	(v) partnering or contracting with an urban ranger or conservation corp operated by a
50	state institution of higher education or similar service-oriented organizations or programs:
51	(A) to provide trail, river, and parkway maintenance, invasive species removal and
52	revegetation, emergency care, and environmental education for the area 250 yards on each side
53	of the Jordan River from the edge of the river for the entire length of the river; and
54	(B) to report to the appropriate public official all health, safety, or law enforcement
55	concerns that the organization encounters, as directed by the commission; [and]
56	(vi) partnering or contracting with local law enforcement or a certified peace officer to
57	provide patrol, security, and law enforcement for the area 250 yards on each side of the Jordan
58	River from the edge of the river for the entire length of the river; and

59	(vii) monitoring the activities of state and local highway authorities and work with the
60	highway authorities to:
61	(A) identify opportunities to have consistent, attractive signs, barriers, and fences
62	where a highway, as defined in Section 72-1-102, crosses or runs adjacent to the Jordan River;
63	<u>and</u>
64	(B) provide access from a highway to the trails along the Jordan River where the trail
65	can be safely accessed; and
66	(b) purchase, lease, sell, or dispose of property or an easement within the zone to
67	achieve the goals in Subsection (2)(a).
68	(3) (a) Before engaging in any activity described in Subsections (2)(a)(i) through
69	(2)(a)(iii) or Subsection (2)(b), the division shall receive the approval of:
70	(i) the commission;
71	(ii) any relevant governmental entity that owns or is responsible for the maintenance of
72	real property within the zone, including Salt Lake County Flood Control; and
73	(iii) the relevant municipality within the zone.
74	(b) Before engaging in any activity described in Subsections (2)(a)(iv) through
75	(2)(a)(vi), the division shall:
76	(i) receive the approval of the commission; and
77	(ii) consult with:
78	(A) any relevant governmental entity that owns or is responsible for the maintenance of
79	real property within the zone; and
80	(B) the relevant municipality within the zone.
81	(4) The programs described in this section may only be implemented as appropriations
82	from the Legislature allow.
83	(5) The Department of Transportation shall post signs developed under Subsection
84	(2)(a)(vii)(A) on state highways that cross the Jordan River on or before June 30, 2022.
