11	NEW S	SECTION. Section 1. Tribal drinking and driving prevention task force. (1) The department	
12	may provide st	ate recognition to the northern tribes DUI task force.	
13	(2)	To be recognized by the department under this section, the northern tribes DUI task force:	
14	(a)	must have members representing each of the participating tribal governments;	
15	(b)	shall study the problem of alcohol-related traffic accidents; and	
16	(c)	shall develop and recommend to the participating tribal governments a program designed to:	
17	(i)	prevent driving while under the influence of alcohol;	
18	(ii)	reduce alcohol-related traffic accidents, injuries, and deaths; and	
19	(iii)	educate the public on the dangers of driving after consumption of alcoholic beverages or other	
20	chemical substances that impair judgment or motor functions.		
21	(3)	The northern tribes DUI task force recognized under this section is eligible to receive funding	
22	appropriated to	the task force and any other state funding available for drinking and driving prevention	
23	programs unde	er this part.

25	NEW S	SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated \$150,000 from the general fund to	
26	the department of transportation for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the purposes of funding the		
27	northern tribes DUI task force pursuant to [section 1].

1	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a
2	copy of [this act] to each federally recognized tribal government in Montana.
3	
4	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
5	integral part of Title 61, chapter 2, part 1, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 2, part 1, apply to [section 1].
6	
7	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2023.
