<b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction for the 2025-2026 fiscal year the sum of ninety-five million dollars (\$95,000,000) in recurring funds to increase the School Health Personnel Allotment. These funds shall be used to increase positions for school nurses in order to provide at least one full-time,		



permanent school nurse in every school in a public school unit.

- SECTION 3. Funds provided pursuant to this act shall supplement and not supplant any funds from any source already provided for school nurses.

  SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025. Section 1 of this act applies
