2 **Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard – Municipal Electric Utilities**

3 FOR the purpose of setting the renewable energy portfolio standard for municipal electric
4 utilities for certain years; and generally relating to the renewable energy portfolio
5 standard.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Utilities**

14 7–703.

15 (e) **(1)** The required percentage of an electric cooperative’s renewable energy
16 portfolio standard derived from solar energy shall be 2.5% in 2020 and later.

17 **(2) THE REQUIRED PERCENTAGE OF A MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC**
18 **UTILITY’S RENEWABLE ENERGY PORTFOLIO STANDARD SHALL BE:**

(I) IN 2021:

1. 20.4% FROM TIER 1 RENEWABLE SOURCES,
INCLUDING:

A. AT LEAST 1.95% DERIVED FROM SOLAR ENERGY; AND

B. AN AMOUNT SET BY THE COMMISSION UNDER §
7-704.2(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, NOT TO EXCEED 2.5%, DERIVED FROM OFFSHORE
WIND ENERGY; AND

2. 2.5% FROM TIER 2 RENEWABLE SOURCES; AND

(II) IN 2022 AND LATER, 20.4% FROM TIER 1 RENEWABLE
SOURCES, INCLUDING:

1. AT LEAST 1.95% DERIVED FROM SOLAR ENERGY; AND

2. AN AMOUNT SET BY THE COMMISSION UNDER §
7-704.2(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE, NOT TO EXCEED 2.5%, DERIVED FROM OFFSHORE
WIND ENERGY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2021.
