 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Black Hills National
 - 5 Cemetery Boundary Expansion Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
 - 7 In this Act:

1	(1) Cemetery.—The term "Cemetery" means
2	the Black Hills National Cemetery in Sturgis, South
3	Dakota.
4	(2) FEDERAL LAND.—The term "Federal land"
5	means the approximately 200 acres of Bureau of
6	Land Management land adjacent to the Cemetery,
7	generally depicted as "Proposed National Cemetery
8	Expansion" on the map entitled "Proposed Expan-
9	sion of Black Hills National Cemetery-South Da-
10	kota" and dated June 16, 2016.
11	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
12	the Secretary of the Interior.

4	(B) Effect.—A legal description pub-
5	lished under subparagraph (A) shall have the
6	same force and effect as if included in this Act,
7	except that the Secretary may correct any cler-
8	ical and typographical errors in the legal de-
9	scription.
10	(C) AVAILABILITY.—Copies of the legal de-
11	scription published under subparagraph (A)
12	shall be available for public inspection in the
13	appropriate offices of—
14	(i) the Bureau of Land Management;

16	(ii) the National Cemetery Adminis-
17	tration.
18	(D) Costs.—The Secretary of Veterans
19	Affairs shall reimburse the Secretary for the
20	costs incurred by the Secretary in carrying out
21	this paragraph, including the costs of any sur-
22	veys and other reasonable costs.
23	(b) Withdrawal.—Subject to valid existing rights,
24	for any period during which the Federal land is under the

- 1 administrative jurisdiction of the Secretary of Veterans
- 2 Affairs, the Federal land—
- 3 (1) is withdrawn from all forms of appropria-
- 4 tion under the public land laws, including the mining
- 5 laws, the mineral leasing laws, and the geothermal
- 6 leasing laws; and
- 7 (2) shall be treated as property as defined
- 8 under section 102(9) of title 40, United States Code.
- 9 (c) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—The boundary of
- 10 the Cemetery is modified to include the Federal land.
- 11 (d) Modification of Public Land Order.—Pub-
- 12 lie Land Order 2112, dated June 6, 1960 (25 Fed. Reg.
- 13 5243), is modified to exclude the Federal land.
