A BILL

To amend Immigration and Nationality Act regarding the extension of a foreign state's designation for purposes of temporary protected status, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "TPS Process Reform
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXTENSIONS OF DESIGNATIONS OF TPS COUN-
- 7 TRIES.
- 8 Section 244(b)(3) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1254a(b)(3)) is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (B), by striking "deter-
2	mines" and inserting "determines or makes no de-
3	termination"; and
4	(2) by amending subparagraph (C) to read as
5	follows:
6	"(C) Extension of designation.—If
7	the Attorney General determines under sub-
8	paragraph (A) that a foreign state (or part of

such foreign state) continues to meet the conditions for designation under paragraph (1), the period of designation of the foreign state is extended for an additional period of 6 months (or,

in the discretion of the Attorney General, a pe-

riod of 12 or 18 months).".
