## A BILL

To reauthorize the Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Act of 2005, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stem Cell Therapeutic
- 5 and Research Reauthorization Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE C.W. BILL YOUNG CELL
- 7 TRANSPLANTATION PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 379(d)(2)(B) of the Pub-
- 9 lie Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274k(d)(2)(B)) is
- 10 amended—

- 1 (1) by striking "including remote collection,
- 2 consistent with the inventory" and inserting "includ-
- 3 ing collection, consistent with the inventory"; and
- 4 (2) by inserting "including remote collection,"
- 5 before "consistent with the requirements".
- 6 (b) Advisory Council Meetings.—Subsection (a)
- 7 of section 379 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
- 8 274k) is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 9 paragraph:
- 10 "(7) The Secretary shall convene the Advisory
- 11 Council at least two times each calendar year.".
- 12 (c) Authorization of Appropriations.—Section
- 13 379B of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 274m)
- 14 is amended by striking "\$33,000,000 for fiscal year 2015
- 15 and \$30,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2016 through
- 16 2020" and inserting "\$30,000,000 for each of fiscal years
- 17 2020 through 2024".
- 18 SEC. 3. CORD BLOOD INVENTORY.
- 19 Subsection (g) of section 2 of the Stem Cell Thera-
- 20 peutic and Research Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 274k note)
- 21 is amended to read as follows:
- 22 "(g) Authorization of Appropriations.—To
- 23 carry out this section, there is authorized to be appro-

- 1 priated \$23,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020 through
- 2 2024.".
