To require the Secretary of Defense to provide blood testing for firefighters of the Department of Defense to determine potential exposure to perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, and for other purposes.

1	SECTION 1. PROVISION OF BLOOD TESTING FOR FIRE-
2	FIGHTERS OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TO
3	DETERMINE EXPOSURE TO
4	PERFLUOROALKYL AND POLYFLUOROALKYL
5	SUBSTANCES.
6	The Secretary of Defense shall provide blood testing
7	to determine and document potential exposure to
8	perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (commonly
9	known as "PFAS") for each firefighter of the Department
10	of Defense during the annual physical exam conducted by
11	the Department for each such firefighter.
