## A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of Defense to conduct a study on the impacts that the expansion of wilderness designations in the Western United States would have on the readiness of the Armed Forces of the United States with respect to aviation training, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Safeguarding Readi-
  - 5 ness in Military Aviation Training Act".

1	SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE STUDY ON IMPACTS
2	THAT THE EXPANSION OF WILDERNESS DES-
3	IGNATIONS IN THE WESTERN UNITED STATES
4	WOULD HAVE ON THE READINESS OF THE
5	ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES
6	WITH RESPECT TO AVIATION TRAINING.
7	(a) Study Required.—The Secretary of Defense
8	shall conduct a study on the impacts that the expansion
9	of wilderness designations in the Western United States
10	would have on the readiness of the Armed Forces of the
11	United States with respect to aviation training.
12	(b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
13	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
14	to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and
15	House of Representatives a report on the study required
16	under subsection (a).
