**A RESOLUTION**

1    **Establishing a House Special Committee on Fisheries.**

2    **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

3            **WHEREAS** fishing for personal use helps to define the Alaska lifestyle for many  
4    state residents; and

5            **WHEREAS** sport fishing plays a significant role in the state tourism industry; and

6            **WHEREAS** the commercial fishing industry is one of the state's largest renewable  
7    resource industries; and

8            **WHEREAS** the state's subsistence fisheries are an important use of the state's  
9    fisheries resources; and

10           **WHEREAS** the Alaska State Legislature must be well informed on all issues related  
11   to the fisheries of the state;

12           **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee  
13   on Fisheries is established to study fishery issues relevant to the state; and be it

14           **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
15   determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee, appoint the  
16   members, and designate a member or members to chair the committee; and be it

- 1           **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Fisheries may meet  
2   during and between sessions of the Thirty-Third Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on  
3   the convening of the First Regular Session of the Thirty-Fourth Alaska State Legislature.
