A BILL

To require the Director of National Intelligence and the Director of the Central Intelligence Agency to conduct a study to identify supply chains critical to national security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supply Chain Vulner-
5 ability Assessment Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. STUDY ON SUPPLY CHAINS CRITICAL TO NATIONAL**
2 **SECURITY.**

3 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
4 ment of this Act, the Director of National Intelligence and
5 the Director of the Central Intelligence Agency shall joint-
6 ly—

7 (1) complete a study—

8 (A) to identify—

9 (i) supply chains that are critical to
10 the national security, economic security, or
11 public health or safety of the United
12 States; and

13 (ii) important vulnerabilities in such
14 supply chains; and

15 (B) to develop recommendations for legis-
16 lative or administrative action to secure the
17 supply chains identified under subparagraph
18 (A)(i); and

19 (2) submit to the congressional intelligence
20 committees (as that term is defined in section 3 of
21 the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C.
22 3003)) the findings of the directors with respect to
23 the study conducted under paragraph (1).

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
