5	This bill changes the allocation of money from a historical support special group license
6	plate.
7	Highlighted Provisions:
8	This bill:
9	 provides the allocation of money from the voluntary contribution for a historical support
10	special group license plate, allocating revenue to the sponsoring agency and to the
11	Transportation Investment Fund of 2005;
12	requires the Motor Vehicle Division to provide notice regarding the allocation of the
13	money from the historical support special group license plate;
14	 provides that a vintage vehicle is not required to make the voluntary contribution to
15	obtain the historical support special group license plate;
16	• amends the definition of a vintage vehicle to exclude the requirement regarding the type
17	of license plate to be displayed; and
18	makes technical changes.
