- 4 (a) Designation.—The facility of the United States
- 5 Postal Service located at 1730 18th Street in Bakersfield,
- 6 California, shall be known and designated as the "Merle
- 7 Haggard Post Office Building".
- 8 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- $2\,$ be deemed to be a reference to the "Merle Haggard Post

3 Office Building".
