A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Gray Wolf State Man-
- 5 agement Act of 2017".

1	SEC. 2. REISSUANCE OF FINAL RULE REGARDING GRAY
2	WOLVES IN THE WESTERN GREAT LAKES.
3	Before the end of the 60-day period beginning on the
4	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
5	shall reissue the final rule published on December 28
6	2011 (76 Fed. Reg. 81666), without regard to any other
7	provision of statute or regulation that applies to issuance
8	of such rule. Such reissuance shall not be subject to judi-
9	cial review.
10	SEC. 3. REISSUANCE OF FINAL RULE REGARDING GRAY
11	WOLVES IN WYOMING.
12	Before the end of the 60-day period beginning on the
13	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
14	shall reissue the final rule published on September 10,
15	2012 (77 Fed. Reg. 55530), without regard to any other
16	provision of statute or regulation that applies to issuance
