- (e) If a local school district receives funding in addition to the state aid received under AS 14.17, including funding through a grant or an appropriation, the local school board shall allocate to the charter school an amount from the additional funding that is proportional to the annual program budget the local school board provides to the charter school under (a) of this section in relation to the state aid the local school district received under AS 14.17.
