A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to education; relating to funding for charter schools; and relating to**
2 **services for children with disabilities."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.03.260 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (e) If a local school district receives funding in addition to the state aid
6 received under AS 14.17, including funding through a grant or an appropriation, the
7 local school board shall allocate to the charter school an amount from the additional
8 funding that is proportional to the annual program budget the local school board
9 provides to the charter school under (a) of this section in relation to the state aid the
10 local school district received under AS 14.17.

11 * **Sec. 2.** AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 **Sec. 14.30.282. Provision of medically necessary services in a school**
13 **setting.** (a) Each school district shall establish and implement written procedures to
14 allow a child with a disability who has a medical diagnosis and presents a prescription

1 from a qualified health care professional to access medically necessary services in a
2 school setting.

3 (b) In this section,

4 (1) "health care provider" has the meaning given in AS 08.02.130(j);

5 (2) "qualified health care professional" means a health care provider
6 who is licensed in this state or board certified.

7 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
8 read:

9 **APPLICABILITY.** AS 14.03.260(e), added by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to contracts
10 entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act.
