

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the George Rogers Clark High School Cardinals, 2022
2 Kentucky High School Athletic Association Boys' Basketball Champions.

3 WHEREAS, on March 19, 2022, in front of a crowd of 11,957, the George Rogers
4 Clark High School Cardinals defeated the Dragons of Warren Central High School by a
5 score of 43 to 42 in the championship game of the UK HealthCare Boys' Sweet Sixteen;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, the victory in the championship game marked the Cardinals' second
8 state championship in school history and capped off an incredible season of 37 wins
9 against just a single loss, with an undefeated record against schools from Kentucky; and

10 WHEREAS, the season-long dominance of the Cardinals, the top-ranked team in
11 the state all year, was perhaps best evidenced by their 31-point average margin of victory
12 prior to the semifinals of the Sweet Sixteen; and

13 WHEREAS, while most of the season showcased the Cardinals' dominance, their
14 toughness and resiliency were evident as they survived the true test of a champion on the
15 Saturday of the Sweet Sixteen, defeating Lincoln County in double overtime in the
16 morning semifinal before winning the championship in a one-point thriller that evening;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, the championship game was a tense affair, with both teams making
19 huge runs, and the Cardinals found themselves trailing the Dragons by five points, 36 to
20 31, with 7 minutes and 21 seconds remaining in the game; and

21 WHEREAS, the Cardinals proceeded to go on an 11-2 run, with four different
22 players scoring, capped off by a three-point play by junior Trent Edwards with 1 minute
23 and 11 seconds left on the clock, giving the Cardinals a 43-38 lead, from which they held
24 on for the victory; and

25 WHEREAS, the Cardinals placed three players on the All-Tournament Team:
26 junior guard Jerone Morton, who was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player; and
27 senior guards Aden Sloan and Tanner Walton; and

1 WHEREAS, other members of the Cardinals' squad included seniors Chester
2 Abbott, Armaan Manak, Stanley Smothers, and Sammy Hernandez; juniors Tyleik
3 Maxwell, Sam Parrish, and Kareem Guerrant; and sophomores Jaylen Berry, Brady
4 Davis, JP Gaines, Jacob Smith, and Reshaun Hampton; and

5 WHEREAS, the Cardinals were coached to victory by Josh Cook, who, in 6 seasons
6 with the Cardinals, has amassed a record of 176 wins and 39 losses, including three
7 consecutive 10th Region Championships; and

8 WHEREAS, Coach Cook was assisted by coaches Joseph Gomes, Taylor Howard,
9 Dylan James, and Jason Neely; and

10 WHEREAS, the hard work, dedication, and achievements of the George Rogers
11 Clark Cardinals are surely worthy of public recognition as they have cemented their place
12 in the annals of Kentucky interscholastic sports history;

13 NOW, THEREFORE,

14 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
15 ***Kentucky:***

17 hereby join Senator Ralph Alvarado in congratulating the George Rogers Clark High
