## A BILL

To require the maintenance of the country of origin markings for imported goods produced in the West Bank or Gaza, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Anti-BDS Labeling
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONTINUATION IN EFFECT OF COUNTRY OF ORIGIN
- 7 MARKING POLICY FOR IMPORTED GOODS
- 8 PRODUCED IN THE WEST BANK OR GAZA.
- 9 The policy of the Government of the United States
- 10 with respect to country of origin marking of imported

- 1 goods produced in the West Bank or Gaza, notice of which
- 2 was published by U.S. Customs and Border Protection in
- 3 the Federal Register on December 23, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg.
- 4 83984), shall remain in effect until repealed by an Act
- 5 of Congress.
- 6 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO RESCIND OR
- 7 CHANGE THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN MARKING
- 8 POLICY FOR IMPORTED GOODS PRODUCED
- 9 IN THE WEST BANK OR GAZA.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, none of
- 11 the funds authorized to be appropriated or otherwise made
- 12 available for the Department of State or U.S. Customs
- 13 and Border Protection on or after the date of the enact-
- 14 ment of this Act may be obligated or expended to prepare
- 15 or promulgate any policy, guidance, regulation, notice, or
- 16 Executive order or to otherwise implement, administer, or
- 17 enforce any policy that rescinds or changes the policy of
- 18 the Government of the United States with respect to coun-
- 19 try of origin marking of imported goods produced in the
- 20 West Bank or Gaza, notice of which was published by U.S.
- 21 Customs and Border Protection in the Federal Register
- 22 on December 23, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg. 83984).
