3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal School Federal
5 Insurance Parity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE INDIAN HEALTH CARE IM-**
2 **PROVEMENT ACT.**

3 Section 409 of the Indian Health Care Improvement
4 Act (25 U.S.C. 1647b) is amended by inserting “or the
5 Tribally Controlled Schools Act of 1988 (25 U.S.C. 2501
6 et seq.)” after “(25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.)”.
