BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 1 2 That Section(s) 21–809(a)(3) through (7) and (9), respectively, of Article – Transportation 3 of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 21–809(a)(4) through (8) and (10), respectively. 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 5 6 as follows: 7 Article - Transportation 8 21 - 809.9 In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. (a) (1) **(3)** "CHILD CARE CENTER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 9.5-401 10 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE. 11 12 [(8)] **(9)** "Speed monitoring system" means a device with one or more motor vehicle sensors producing recorded images of motor vehicles traveling at speeds at 13 least 12 miles per hour above the posted speed limit. 14 15 (b) A speed monitoring system may not be used in a local jurisdiction 16 under this section unless its use is authorized by the governing body of the local jurisdiction 17 by local law enacted after reasonable notice and a public hearing. 18 This section applies to a violation of this subtitle recorded by a speed monitoring system that meets the requirements of this subsection and has been 19 20 placed: 211. In Montgomery County, on a highway in a residential 22 district, as defined in § 21–101 of this title, with a maximum posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour, which speed limit was established using generally accepted traffic engineering 23 24practices: 252.In a school zone with a posted speed limit of at least 20 26 miles per hour; [or] 27 3. ON A HIGHWAY WITHIN A ONE-HALF MILE RADIUS OF A CHILD CARE CENTER WITH A POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF AT LEAST 20 MILES PER 2829 HOUR; OR 30 4. In Prince George's County:
- A. Subject to subparagraph (vii) of this paragraph, on Maryland Route 210 (Indian Head Highway); or

B. On that part of a highway located within the grounds of an institution of higher education as defined in § 10–101(h) of the Education Article, or within one—half mile of the grounds of a building or property used by the institution of higher education where generally accepted traffic and engineering practices indicate that motor vehicle, pedestrian, or bicycle traffic is substantially generated or influenced by the institution of higher education.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
