- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Liberty Res-
- 5 toration Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RESTORING INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY.
- 7 (a) Repeal of Requirement To Maintain Min-
- 8 IMUM ESSENTIAL COVERAGE.—
- 9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Internal Revenue Code
- of 1986 is amended by striking chapter 48 (and the
