A BILL

To amend the Social Security Act relating to the use of
determinations made by the Commissioner.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Social Security Bene-
5 ficiary 2nd Amendment Rights Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. USE OF DETERMINATIONS MADE BY THE COMMIS-**
7 **SIONER.**

8 (a) TITLE II.—Section 205(j) of the Social Security
9 Act (42 U.S.C. 405(j)) is amended by adding at the end
10 the following:

1 “(11) No determination by the Commissioner of So-
2 cial Security with respect to an individual, including a de-
3 termination that benefits under this title to which such
4 individual is entitled shall be paid to a representative
5 payee, shall be considered to be a determination that the
6 individual has been adjudicated as a mental defective for
7 purposes of subsections (d)(4) and (g)(4) of section 922
8 of title 18, United States Code.”.

9 (b) TITLE XVI.—Section 1631(a)(2) of such Act (42
10 U.S.C. 1383(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the end the
11 following:

12 “(J) No determination by the Commissioner of Social
13 Security with respect to an individual, including a deter-
14 mination that benefits under this title to which such indi-
15 vidual is entitled shall be paid to a representative payee,
16 shall be considered to be a determination that the indi-
17 vidual has been adjudicated as a mental defective for pur-
18 poses of subsections (d)(4) and (g)(4) of section 922 of
19 title 18, United States Code.”.

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
