- 3 SECTION 1. STUDY ON RADIATION EXPOSURE RELATING
- 4 TO PROSTATE CANCER.
- 5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
- 6 seek to enter into an agreement with the National Acad-
- 7 emies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine or the Na-

- 1 tional Cancer Institute to conduct a study to determine
- 2 whether prostate cancer should be added to the list of dis-
- 3 eases specified in section 1112(c) of title 38, United States
- 4 Code, and considered to have been incurred in or aggra-
- 5 vated during the active military, naval, or air service of
- 6 radiation-exposed veterans.
- 7 (b) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the date
- 8 on which the Secretary receives the study conducted pur-
- 9 suant to subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to the
- 10 Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Rep-
- 11 resentatives and the Senate a report on such study.
