7	(a) In General.—Section 3313(c)(1)(B) of title 38,
8	United States Code, is amended—
9	(1) by striking clause (iii);
10	(2) by redesignating clause (iv) as clause (iii);
11	and
12	(3) in clause (i), in the matter preceding sub-
13	clause (I), by striking "clauses (ii) and (iii)" and in-
14	serting "clause (ii)".
15	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
16	subsection (a) shall apply to a quarter, semester, or term
17	beginning on or after August 1, 2020.
