CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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Anne Arundel County - Board of License Commissioners

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of License Commissioners for 4 Anne Arundel County; requiring that each member of the Board represent a different 5 legislative district in the county; requiring that the Governor appoint members who 6 have lived in their district for a certain time period; specifying that a member's seat 7 be declared vacant under certain circumstances; requiring that no more than a 8 certain number of members may belong to the same political party; providing that 9 the term of a member continues for a certain number of years and ends on a certain 10 date; providing for the termination of the terms of members of the Board serving on 11 a certain date; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners for 12 Anne Arundel County.



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during the remainder of the term of office of the individual originally appointed in

accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

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(2) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
(e) (1) The Governor may remove a member for misconduct in office, incompetence, or willful neglect of duty.
(2) The Governor shall give a member who is charged a copy of the charges against the member and, with at least 10 days' notice, an opportunity to be heard publicly in person or by counsel.
(3) If a member is removed, the Governor shall file with the Office of the Secretary of State a statement of charges against the member and the Governor's findings on the charges.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members serving on the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County on the effective date of this Act shall expire at the end of June 30, 2017.
SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2017.
